- Maintain a contractor safety management program that ensures contractor personnel perform work in a manner consistent with the requirements contained within our Safety and Health policies and procedures.
- Continuously improve our risk assessment culture and to eliminate or minimize risk as low as reasonably practical.
- Provide appropriate resources and processes to implement and maintain an effective Safety and Health management system.
- Support Covia Team Members in stopping work or equipment when there is concern of an immediate or imminent exposure to a hazard that poses a risk to safety or health.
- Provide the necessary information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure we achieve a way of working that incorporates a philosophy of safe production as a part of every shift.
- Maintain processes for receiving, considering and responding to information and recommendations regarding Safety and Health incidents, hazards and risks.
- Monitor, audit, review and verify the effectiveness of our Safety and Health management systems, to identify and address non-conformances, improvement opportunities and communicate outcomes and priorities.
